



Cookie Policy

This Policy applies to the cookies used on www.lexpertistranslation.com website (the **Website**) operated by Quo Vadis Services Ltd (registered seat: H-1147 Budapest, Zsolnay Vilmos utca 3. 4/2.; tax number: HU24874155) as service provider (the **LSP**).

This Website places data files called “cookies” on your computer from time to time in order to ensure the proper functioning of this Website.

WHAT IS COOKIE ABOUT?

Cookies are small text files placed by the Website to its visitors’ computers and/or mobile devices. Thanks to cookies, the Website memorizes the steps made by You and Your personal settings (e.g. Your user name, the language used by You, font size and other custom settings relating to the viewing of the Website) for a certain period of time, so You do not have to provide such details repeatedly each time You visit the Website or navigate from one page to another.

WHY DO WE USE COOKIES?

Cookies contain information (e.g. the time spent on certain webpages), which help the LSP to personalise the Website content based on Your needs.

The LSP may also use cookies in an anonymised form (i.e. without identifying you personally), for the purpose of preparing statistics. Those statistics provide the LSP with a guidance on how You use the Website and allows for the LSP to improve the content and the structure of the Website in order to the best possible user experience for You.

By accepting the cookies, using the Website may become easier for You, as - thanks to cookies - the Website, *inter alia*:

- detects if You have visited the Website before;
- remembers Your settings, so you do not need to give such details again;
- remembers the data provided by you before.

WHAT KIND OF COOKIES DO WE USE?

The LSP uses two types of cookies at the Website:

- **temporary cookies** (also known as “session cookies”), which remain on Your device while You are staying on the Website; and
- **persistent cookies**, which may remain on Your device for a longer time or until when they are deleted manually, depending on Your browser settings. Certain cookies are essential for the functioning of the Website, while other cookies are used to improve performance and user experience.

The classification of cookies generally used on websites is shown in the following table:

DO WE USE THIRD PARTY COOKIES?

From time to time, the Website displays content by using web-based services of third parties. The use of such services may only result in the storage of cookies, which are not monitored by the LSP, therefore the LSP exercises no control as to what types of data are collected by such third parties. You can find further information on the use of such cookies at the website of the relevant third party.

By using **Google Analytics**, the LSP collect data about the manner You and other visitors use the Website. The data so collected do not identify You personally, but they help the LSP to adapt the Website to Your and other visitors' needs as much as possible. Google Analytics may place the following cookies on Your computer:

__utma	Used to distinguish users and sessions.	2 years from set/update
__utmt	Used to throttle request rate.	10 minutes
__utmb	Used to determine new sessions/visits.	30 mins from set/update
__utmc	Used to determine whether the user is in a new session/visit.	End of browser session
__utmz	Stores the traffic source or campaign that explains how the user reached your site.	6 months from set/update
